The Ministry of Corporate Affairs vide its notification dated February 11, 2022 has introduced the Companies (Accounts) Amendment Rules, 2022. The Rules provides that every company covered under the provisions of section 135 (1) of the Companies Act, 2013 shall be required to furnish a report on CSR in form CSR-2 to the Registrar commencing from the preceding financial year (2020-21) as an addendum to form AOC-4 or AOC-4 XBRL or AOC-4 NBFC (Ind AS) as may be applicable. We will elucidate the key points in filing Form CSR-2 and also the intent of the ministry in introducing this form.
